Elementary Chorale Description: A group of students that wish to glorify the Lord by using their voices in song. It is a group that sharpens their musical skills in rehearsal and several performances throughout the year. Most of all, the Elementary Chorale is a group that will set an example for other students to follow in the areas of worship, behavior and Christian walk.

Elementary Chorale Objectives:

- To glorify the Lord with our voices through all types of music
- To learn how to work together as a unit and sing with one voice and spirit
- To grow in our knowledge of music, the voice and to have a lot of fun!

Course Requirements:

1. Mandatory attendance at **ALL** rehearsals and performances (Check the website!)
2. Practice your music at home
3. Choir is a year long commitment
4. There are additional expenses involved in being a member of Elem. Choir (One-time lab fee, choir attire, field trips)

Attendance:

1. Tardiness is not acceptable at **any** time!
2. If a student is *not present on time and in uniform*, their performance grade will be reduced one percentage point for each minute late
3. Absence from a performance will only be excused if the parent supplies me with a note indicating that the student was seriously ill or the death of an immediate family member has occurred

Classroom Policies:

- Students must walk quietly and respectfully to the choir classroom
- No talking, singing, or playing while the teacher is talking
- Practice Ephesians 4:29 at all times

Discipline: If a student continues to refrain from following the classroom rules before, during, or after Elementary choir rehearsals/performances, the student will be immediately dismissed from the Elementary Chorale
