Honor Choir Description: A group of students that wish to glorify the Lord by using their voices in song. It is a group that sharpens their musical skills in rehearsal and in many different performances throughout the year. Most of all, Remembrance is a group that will set a good example for other students to follow in the areas of worship, behavior and Christian walk.

Honor Choir Objectives:

- To glorify the Lord with our voices through all types of music
- To learn how to work together as a unit and sing with one voice and spirit
- To grow in our knowledge of music theory, the voice and to have a lot of fun! 😊

Course Requirements:

1. Mandatory attendance at **ALL** rehearsals and performances (Check the website!)
2. Practice your music at home
3. Choir is a year long commitment
4. There are additional expenses involved in being a member of H.S. Choir
(*One time lab fee, choir attire, costumes/props, field trips, folder to store music*)

Grading:

- Homework 20% = (music theory worksheets)
- Participation 15% = (classroom activities and rehearsals)
- Performances 30% = (largest chunk of the grade – see info below)
- Tests/Quizzes 20% = (music theory and singing)
- Semester Final 15%

Attendance:

1. Tardiness is not acceptable at **any** time!
2. If a student is *not present on time and in uniform*, their performance grade will be reduced one percentage point for each minute late
3. Absence from a performance will only be excused if the parent supplies me with a note indicating that the student was seriously ill or the death of an immediate family member has occurred

Classroom Policies:

- Be on time for rehearsal with music out and sitting in your seat
- No talking, singing, or playing while the instructor or someone else is talking
- Always come equipped to class (pencil, paper, music folder etc.)

Discipline:

- If a student accumulates numerous demerits, the student will be immediately referred to administration.



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High School Honor Choir Covenant

1. Staying informed of upcoming events via choir website, emails, texts and fliers
